See the chart below to identify your next steps. **Please note, more than one of these processes may be applicable for a single funding application.**

Yes: Each named researcher in the application is required to complete an attestation form (see right) confirming there are no affiliations with institutions on the Named Research Organizations (NRO) list. 2. Are you applying for federal Tri-Agency / CFI funding with one or more private sector partners?	 Yes: As per the National Security Guidelines for Research Partnerships (NSGRP), the funding program may require you to complete this <u>Risk Assessment</u> Form (RAF). Only one NSGRP-RAF is required per application, regardless of the number of partners. Review this <u>list of eligible Tri-Agency programs</u> and <u>CFI programs</u> to confirm if this is required of you.
