## ORF-RE Round 10 - 2019 Internal U of T Notice of Intent Instructions

UofT internal NOIs for the ORF-RE Rd 10:

- are due <u>July 19, 2019</u> this will include notification of non-U of T-led projects in which U of T faculty members are participating
- should be submitted as PDFs to rso.vpr@utoronto.ca

There is a very short timeline that has been provided by the sponsor in order to develop these applications, therefore, it will be advantageous to have a collaborative relationship with the matching private sector partners at this stage. The Sponsors website is as follows, application form and guidelines have now been posted: https://www.ontario.ca/page/ontario-research-fund-research-excellence

While the sponsor has now removed an NOI stage, we retain this for internal purposes in order to ensure we have sufficient resources for application review and to assist with budget development of these proposals. NOIs will not be adjudicated.

## Completing the NOI form:

- 1. Working Title of the Application: this can be changed subsequently.
- 2. **Lead Investigator and Administering Unit/Division:** can also be changed later; must be a U of T faculty member eligible to hold research funding
- **3. Brief description of project and provincial significance:** provide sufficient information to enable readers to understand the nature of the proposal and, importance to Ontario
- 4. **Estimated Total Project Cost:** As close an estimate as possible at this early stage, to enable an institution-level assessment of total ORF-RE funding proposed at this early stage
- 5. **Eligible Partner Organizations:** Include any research partner institution that will be receiving (aka subgranted) ORF-RE funds, or providing matching
- 6. **Eligible matching Private Sector Partners:** List all of the PSP and the amounts you anticipate they will be contributing in cash and/or in kind.
- 7. **Eligible Institutional matching:** List all of the Institutional sources of matching and amounts you anticipate.
