Sherbrooke CFREF Sustainability Assessment

- We recognized early on that while our scientific output was excellent, our most valuable products—and primary exports were the talented individuals we trained, most of whom were leaving the country upon completion of their programs.
- Our partnerships were predominantly international, which prevented us from accessing most provincial and federal funding programs that required local stakeholder participation.
- We needed to find a way to reverse this trend and create a virtuous cycle: one where we could generate intellectual property, build commercial value, and retain our talent domestically.





5-steps strategy for CFREF sustainability in quantum science

Step 1: Obtain the University official recognition

Step 2: « Physically » exist (so that they cannot get rid of you)

Step 3: Nurture the local ecosystem

Step 4: Learn the « political game » (and play it)

Step 5: International partnership




